Brazos Valley Pasture & Hayfield Pre-Emergent Applications

Each year, farmers and ranchers battle challenging weeds that threaten forage quality and quantity in their hayfields and pastures. Producers offers pre-emergent herbicides that help with long-term weed control, and residual activity to help decrease weed pressure and increase forage production.

Timing is everything when considering pre-emergent applications in forage production. Early is on time, and the time is now. Applications should be complete prior to weed germination. Weeds begin to germinate when soil temperatures maintain a minimum of 52 degrees. For the Brazos Valley, soil temperatures typically reach a constant 52 degrees by mid-February (Valentine's Day). Rainfall is also important for a successful application. A 0.25"-0.5" of rainfall or irrigation is needed to activate the herbicide and incorporate into the soil.

Both Rezilon and Prowl H2O pre-emergent herbicides are great options for long-term weed control and residual in your hayfields and pastures.
