Cheyenne II- A certified and stable hybrid variety that is high yielding, palatable and digestible. Excellent for grazing and hay production, Cheyenne II is also deeply rooted for heat and drought tolerance. Planting rate is 7-10lbs per acre.

Tierra Verde- An economical, all-purpose blend of several Bermuda varieties. This variety emerges rapidly for a quick cover, forms a dense sod, and offers excellent durability and wear. Ideal for horse pastures and paddocks. Planting rate is 7-10lbs per acre.

Bermuda Triangle- A turf grass blend that is widely adapted to provide superior durability and wear. Bermuda Triangle forms a dense, dark green sod with a fine texture that is both beautiful and able to withstand heavy traffic. Planting rate is 2-3lbs per 1000 square feet.

From The Ground Up

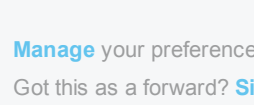
