Heat Stress in Cattle

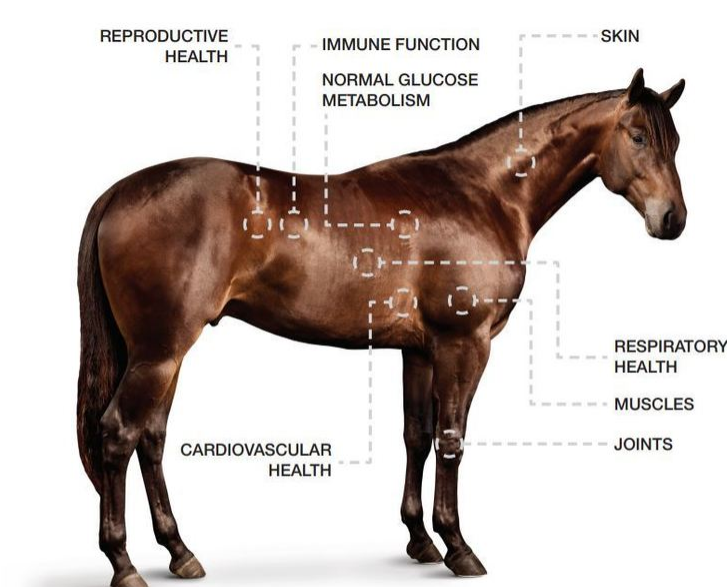
With the upcoming summer months, your cattle will experience the hot Texas weather. Making sure that pastures & facilities are setup to limit the occurrence of heat stress in our herds is crucial for several reasons. Heat stress can cause milk production to decrease, loss in weight gain, a reduction in feed intake and even depress fertility. Signs of heat stress may include open mouth breathing or panting, loss of coordination, foaming at the mouth and convulsions. Ranchers can prevent or minimize heat stress by:

- Providing plenty of fresh, clean water.
- Sufficient shade that may include trees or other structures; such as, shade cloth.
- Feeding & working cattle during the cooler parts of the day.
