For the removal and control of lungworms (Dictyocaulus vinparus) barberpole worms (Haemonchus contortus); brown stomach worms (Ostertagia ostertagi); small stomach worms (Trichostrongylus axei); hookworms (Bunostomum phlebotomum); thread-necked intestinal worms (Nematodirus helvetianus); small intestinal worms (Cooperia punctatata and Coooperia oncophera); bankrupt worms (Trichostrongylus colubriformis); and nodular worms (Oesophagostomum radiatum).

### **INGREDIENTS**

## FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed as the sole ration for one day. Feed at the rate of 0.5 pound of Cattle Dewormer Cubes per 100 pounds of bodyweight to provide 2.27 milligrams fenbendazole per pound of bodyweight. See the table for additional feeding amounts based on various beef cattle bodyweights. Sufficient space must be available so all animals can eat at the same time to ensure uniform consumption.

CAUTION: A withdrawal period has not been established for this product in pre-ruminating calves. Do not use in calves to processed for veal.

LIMITATIONS: Feed as sole ration or top dress for one day. Retreatment may be needed after 4 to 6 weeks. Cattle must not be sluaghtered within 13 days following last treatment. Do not use within 13 days of slaughter. For dairy cattle the milk discard is zero hours.

Note: Consult veterinarian for assistance in the diagnosis, treatment and control of parasitism.
