FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed PRODUCERS SHOW GOAT at the rate of 2.5 to 5 pounds per head per day. Provide adequate amounts of forage (hay or pasture), with unlimited access to fresh, clean water. Adding grain products to goat diet can often result in the development of urinary calculi. Consult your nutritionist before making such modifications.





CAUTION: Do not allow horses or other equines access to feeds containing Monensin. Ingestion of Monensin by equines has been fatal. Monensin medicated cattle and goat feeds are safe for use in cattle and goats only. Consumption by unapproved species may result in toxic reactions. Do not exceed the levels of monensin recommended in the feeding directions, as reduced average daily gains may result. Do not feed to lactating goats.
