INGREDIENTS

Cottonseed meal, dehulled soybean meal, cane molasses, calcium carbonate, salt, urea, monocalcium phosphate, dicalcium phosphate, soybean meal, corn gluten feed, defluorinated phosphate, vitamin A acetate, calcium sulfate, linseed meal, manganous oxide, zinc oxide, copper sulfate, magnesium oxide ferrous sulfate, mineral oil, potassium sulfate, potassium iodide, sodium selenite, vitamin E supplement, cholecalciferol (source of Vitamin D₃), cobalt carbonate.

DIRECTIONS

MoorMan's Mintrate Blocks are for self-feeding to cattle on pasture or with all-roughage rations. After making sure animals have adequate pasture or roughage and are not starved for minerals or salt, remove salt or minerals and feed the blocks free-choice. The blocks may be fed on the ground, but it is best to feed in bunks or boxes. Protect the blocks for heavy rains to minimize waste.

Moorman's Mintrate Blocks are available with different levels of palatability. Consumptions of the Mintrate Blocks will vary according to the animal's body weight and the quality and quantity of available roughage. When forage is lush and of good quality, the most palatable block is recommended. If the pasture or roughage is coarse, fibrous or shot in supple, the least palatable block is recommended. Recommended consumption of Mintrate Block is 0.05 to 0.10 pounds per 100 lbs body weight daily, depending type and quality of forage fed. A 10 day supply of blocks may be put out at one time, and not less than one block for each 10 to 12 animals is recommended.

MoorMan's Mintrate Block is not a complete feed, and must be fed with pasture and/or roughage. Mintrate Blocks consumed in recommended amounts will supply adequate minerals. If pasture and/or roughage supple is inadequate energy for satisfactory growth, performance or body condition, supplemental grain or good quality roughage should be fed. MoorMan's Minerals may be fed free choice in addition to Mintrate Blocks if animals consume more than the recommended amount of Mintrate Blocks.
