- If show cattle have not been receiving a high-energy diet, begin feeding 1% of their bodyweight weight per day with free choice grass hay.
- Increase feed slowly over a 14-day period to 2 to 2.5% of bodyweight per day along with free choice grass hay.
- Always allow free access to plenty of clean, fresh water at all times.
- 4. For example, if calves weigh 600 lbs., 1% of bodyweight would be 6 lbs. per day (600 X 0.01 = 6).
